- **Nashville Nightlife Dinner Theater** – a celebration of country music from both past and present.
- **Ryman Auditorium** - historically cool and host to world class entertainment for more than a century and home to exhibits, artifacts and photos from the early Opry years to Johnny & June at the Ryman.
- **The Wildhorse Saloon** – you will be entertained from the moment you step inside the show stopping interior. Lunch, dance lessons and entertainment will give you a chance to kick up a good time.
- **Country Music Hall of Fame** – alive with music and memories you will see the 5,300 square foot Rotunda designated to the members elected into the Hall of Fame.
- **Studio B** – see how some of the greatest hits were produced by singers such as Elvis and Dolly Parton from 1957 to 1977.
- **Guided tour of historic Franklin** founded in 1799 and home to Carnton Plantation, witness to one of the bloodiest battles of the Civil War the home served as a field hospital for wounded. Lunch at Puckett's after the tour.
- **Cheekwood Botanical Garden and Museum of Art** a showcase of color with ten specialty display gardens and natural landscape.
- **The Hermitage**, Home of Andrew Jackson
- **General Jackson Showboat** – cruise along the Cumberland River on this 300 foot paddlewheel riverboat while enjoying lunch and entertainment.
- **The Fontanel Mansion and Farm** – former home of Barbara Mandrell, located on 130 acres with The Farm House Restaurant, venue of your farewell dinner.

- **Grand Old Opry** – guided tour of the museum honoring country music's longest running radio show and its stars.
- **Grand Ole Opry** – evening performance show; performer to be announced at a later date.
