The Great Smoky Mountains are located in the Appalachian Mountain system in western North Carolina and eastern Tennessee. The mountains comprise one of the oldest upland regions in the world. Cherokee Indian Reservation, Great Smoky Mountains National Park, and parts of several national forests are located here. The mountains are named for the smoke like haze characteristic of the region.
